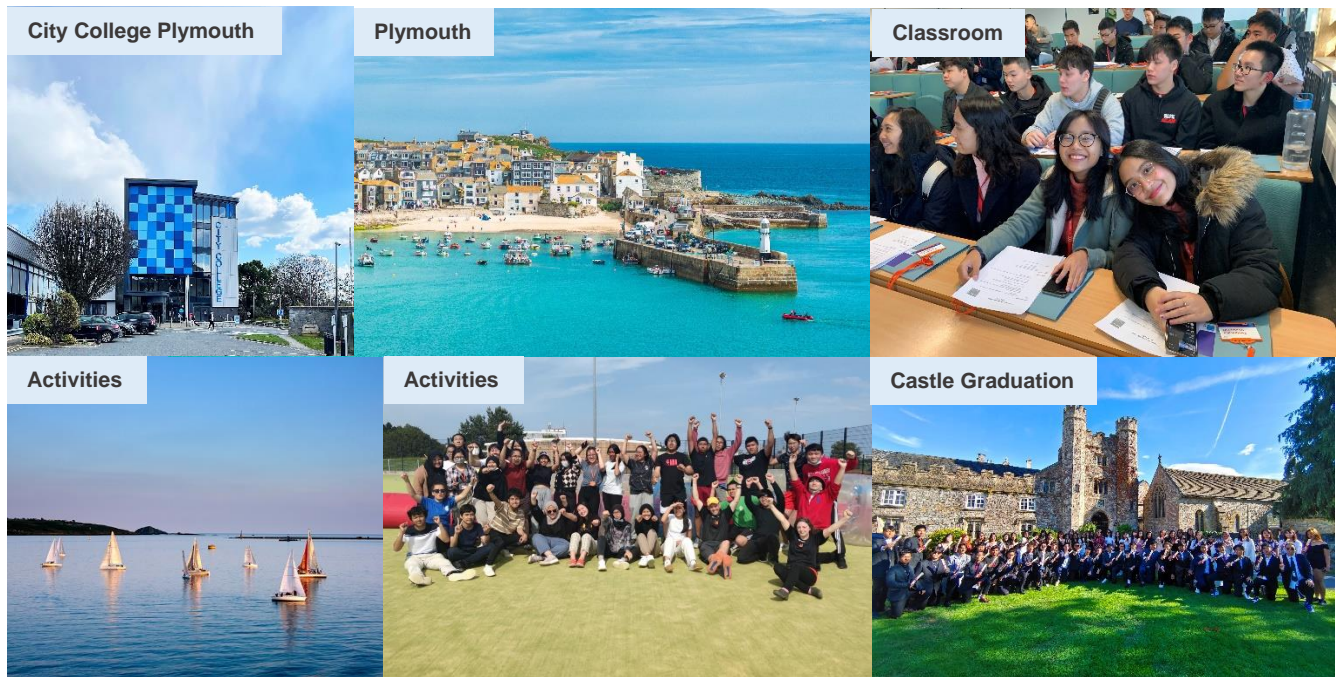

No	Course	Details
1	IELTS Booster/ The Prince EAP/English	12 hours of The Prince English as Academic Purposes taster lessons, with objective to improve participants' overall English level. Participants will need to under take CCP English Placement Test to ascertain their English Proficiency Level.
2	Project: Mayflower	Self Research - Students will be guided on how to work on the project and will need to produce a ppt on this project. They will be visiting to a few Plymouth Places of Interests, learning about history and Plymouth Culture, research, and also come up with a short presentation. Students will be grouped for this project. Group presentation will be in the last day before leaving Plymouth. Project Objective: Students are able to learn as much as possible about Plymouth, and able to use English to do a presentation about Plymouth, and be able to tell stories about Plymouth upon returning to their home countries. This will go along with communication and public speaking course - to improve students communication and public speaking skills, through actual project. Students are expected to present to their school juniors upon returning to their school.
3	Public Speaking and English Communication	15 hours of learning + 1 hour of exam: Spreading the hours to 3 weeks, or 4 weeks maximum. Learning outcome: To improve students' conversation, listening, Public Speaking and Communication skills. Lessons have to involve a lot of conversation practice, and with interview, public speaking, speech elements. Students are expected to deliver a graduation speech in the castle, each speech will be 2 mins, without referring to notes
4	Drama Course	3 x 2 hours Lessons of Drama/Acting: A short drama - engaging students to remember the scripts and also acting. Learning outcome: Students able to understand a storyline, and able to play a role in the story with remembering the script/conversation
5	Nutrition and Sports Course	2 days x 3 hour lesson of Sports/Exercise/Nutrition. Can be 1 hour of classroom learning + 2 hours of actual exercise
6	The Box Museum	Visit this museum, art gallery and archive in Plymouth which housing a collection of about 2 million items. It is also a place where the city's heritage meets contemporary art and archives meet interaction.
7	National Marine Aquarium, Plymouth	The National Marine Aquarium (NMA) is the UK's largest aquarium, and its part of the Ocean Conservation Trust, a charity dedicated to connecting people with Ocean. Students will get a chance to discover an underwater world, with wildlife from all corners of the globe. Including local animals as well as Atlantic Ocean and Great Barrier Reef tanks.
8	Dartmoor and Tavistock	Dartmoor National Park - wild, open moorlands and deep river valleys, with a rich history and rare wildlife, Dartmoor is definitely a unique place for you to explore. Tavistock is an ancient stannary and market town within West Devon, England. It is famous for its pannier market, which now open 5 days a week with variety, vibrance and excitement from stall owners, locals and visitors. Students will get to find crafts, to antiques, to fresh produce.

9	Sports Activity	Plymouth Life Centre, or Basket Ball Match - We aim to engage students either witnessing to real basket ball match, or engaging in sports.
